## REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- ⇒ Identity document
- ⇒ Academic transcript of records
- ⇒ Learning agreement
- ⇒ Statement of interest
- ⇒ Identity photo
- ⇒ Certificate of Bachelor/Master Degree (if applicable)
- ⇒ Proof of language proficiency (if applicable)
- ⇒ Portfolio (only if you apply to the Nature and Landscape Architecture Department)



## LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

B1 level in French required.



## HEALTH INSURANCE

Affiliation to the French social security scheme is compulsory for all International students (except European students).

European students will have to provide a copy of their European Health Insurance Card.
